

CAMERA-READY SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Step 1: Paper formatting

- Prepare your camera-ready PDF versions using the IEEE template.
(<https://www.ieee.org/conferences/publishing/templates.html>)
- Verify the following requirements:
 - The camera-ready PDF version should have embedded fonts.
 - The PDF should not contain page numbers.
 - Do not insert any footers or headers.

Step 2: Inserting the appropriate IEEE copyright notice

- The appropriate copyright clearance code notice should be appeared on the bottom of the first page of each paper. Add one of the copyright notices listed below to the bottom of the first page of your source document. If further assistance is necessary, contact Masaaki Yamanaka at yamanaka@jcgga.ac.jp for the appropriate copyright notice.

- For papers in which all authors are employed by the US government, the copyright notice is:
U.S. Government work not protected by U.S. copyright
- For papers in which all authors are employed by a Crown government (UK, Canada, and Australia), the copyright notice is:
979-8-3315-1236-1/25/\$31.00 ©2025 Crown
- For papers in which all authors are employed by the European Union, the copyright notice is:
979-8-3315-1236-1/25/\$31.00©2025 European Union
- For all other papers the copyright notice is:
979-8-3315-1236-1/25/\$31.00 ©2025 IEEE

Step 3: Copyright transfer to IEEE

- Authors must sign their copyright form via IEEE Electric Copyright Form (IEEE eCF). Please login to your EDAS account and look for your DTPI 2025 accepted paper(s) under your EDAS dashboard, then click on the copyright icon. You will be redirected to the IEEE eCF website where you just need to follow the wizard to complete and submit your copyright online.

Step 4: Generating IEEE Xplore compliant PDF file

- Prior to submitting the camera-ready PDF file, it must be validated by IEEE PDF eXpress to ensure that it is compliant with IEEE Xplore Digital Library.
 - Log in to the PDF eXpress website (<https://ieee-pdf-express.org/>), and generate the IEEE Xplore compliant file. (In case you are a new user, click on “Create account” link and enter the conference ID (65196X), your email address and a password. If you have used previously PDF eXpress you might reuse the same account you used for previous conference.)
 - DTPI 2025 conference ID: 65196X

Step 5: Submitting camera-ready file via EDAS

- The PDF file you generated by IEEE PDF eXpress must be submitted via EDAS.
